### Riverhaven Garage Break-Ins

Very recently, several houses in Riverhaven have had break-ins **through the garage door**; once in garage the thief attempts to steal cars and other valuables such as tools. **Lock your cars** even if they are in your garage; **lock the door that leads into your home** from the garage and **secure any valuables** you may keep in the garage. **Do not leave your remote door opener in any car parked in your driveway.** The thieves may take the remote garage door openers and try to use them on other garages in the neighborhood. Report any unusual activity to the police.
