
## Parking - A Friendly Reminder for the Holidays

Please, follow all parking laws and regulations this holiday – you don't want Santa to bring you a parking ticket for Christmas!

- Paradise Falls from Alvernon to Columbus is a *no parking zone*.
- If our HOA manager sees illegally parked cars on her bimonthly visits to Riverhaven, she calls ParkWise; the City of Tucson's parking enforcement division.
- Because of the number of complaints we receive about parking, we have requested that ParkWise visit Riverhaven on a regular basis.

#### A 10% Raise in Assessments Needed for 2010

After much discussion and research the Board decided to raise the assessment for 2010 10% over the 2009 assessment. This raises the quarterly assessment from \$74 to \$81 and is \$28 more per year for each homeowner. It is the minimum that the Board felt was needed to run the HOA and carry out necessary maintenance projects next year.



After the holidays Christmas trees can be cutup in small pieces and put into the trash; they can be kept out of sight and put out for the spring bulky trash pickup (date TBA) or you can take the tree to be mulched at Rillito Park (4502 N 1st Ave.) on 1/9/10. Do not leave your tree on the curb for the garbage collector to pickup because they *will not take it*. And don't dump the tree in one of the washes. That's wildcat dumping and chances are high that the wash is maintained by the Riverhaven HOA.
