There have been several incidents of vehicle break-ins. **Don't leave valuables in your car!** If you absolutely must, keep them in your trunk, with the trunk release locked. There were also a few A/C units stolen from vacant houses. The last thing you want is for your house to look vacant, or like no one is home. Don't make it easy for criminals! **Leaving exterior lights on overnight helps to deter criminal activity.** If you'll be out for a few hours, leave an interior light on to make it appear someone is home.
